

Toro 570 Series Sprinklers for Landscape and Turf Applications

The most versatile sprinkler you will ever use.

570 Series Sprinklers have been around for more than 27 years. They provide unlimited design flexibility with the versatility of seven distinct sprinkler heads, more than 120 interchangeable nozzles and free PCD with all nozzles (except Variable Arc Nozzles). Radius from 0.6 to 5.2 metres.

The Zero-flush seal prevents flushing on pop-up, enabling more sprinklers to be placed on the same zone, while retraction flushing clears debris for reliable pop-down.

PRX - model

The 570 Series PRX model will save you water. This model features an in-riser pressure regulator that controls high or fluctuating inlet water pressure to a constant outlet pressure of 200 kPa. This eliminates the possibility of misting and wasteful over spray onto footpaths, cars and buildings.

For added conservation of water, the 570 PRX and XF have a patented X-Flow™ shut-off device. This restricts water flow up to 98% if a nozzle is removed or damaged. The shut-off device prevents geysers and the landscape erosion and safety problems that they can create. This is critical on public or commercial properties subject to both vandalism and mower strikes.

The X-Flow™ shut-off valve also allows you to change or service a sprinkler nozzle with the system on. This device can be a real plus with contractors, it makes installations easier and cuts down on maintenance time.

Toro's X-Flow™ device allows less than 2% water loss. Rain Bird®'s 1800 PRS allows up to a 30% water loss.

Toro 570 Z Series versus Hunter®'s SRS Series

The 570Z PRX in-riser pressure regulator and X-Flow™ shut-off device cut high or fluctuating inlet pressure down to an outlet pressure of 200kPa. Hunter®'s SRS does not offer pressure regulation nor does it include an in-riser shut-off valve. For water pressure under 310kPa, Toro offers a less expensive pressure-compensation option free and pre-installed. Hunter does not have a pressure-compensation feature.

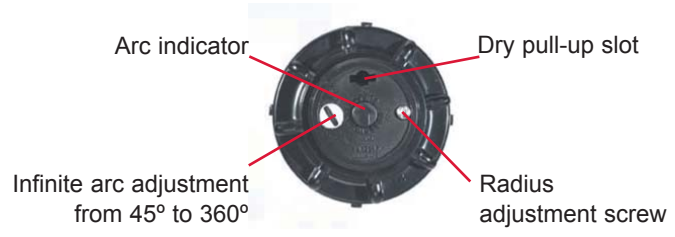
Mini 8 Series Rotor – the perfect in-between

Toro offers the new Mini 8, a 15mm (1/2") gear-drive rotor that provides value. It serves as the perfect in-between fit for your applications where the landscape is too big for sprays, but too small for a full-size rotor.

When using a 15mm rotor you can water efficiently, thereby saving money and water. The cost to irrigate is less per square metre and compared to fixed-sprays, it requires fewer stations to cover an area. The Mini 8 comes with 5 nozzles, pops up 95mm and is fully adjustable from the top of the sprinkler.

Main features are:

- Visible arc indication from the top of sprinkler for infinite adjustments from 45° to 360°
- Five interchangeable nozzles
- Part and full-circle arcs in one sprinkler
- Stainless steel radius adjustment screw allows up to 25% radius reduction
- Pressure activated seal and robust trip mechanism for enhanced reliability
- Ratcheting riser for easy arc adjustment
- Two year warranty
